RECYCLING



All recyclable material is banned from the Benton County Landfill. Please use provided curbside or drop-off recycling programs for your corrugated cardboard, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, steel/aluminum cans, and plastic containers. Call your city hall for more information.

Appliances:

Many appliances contain hazardous materials such as mercury switches or freon. There is a **\$5 charge/appliance** to offset the cost of hazardous material removal and recycling. There is **No Charge** for scrap metals.



Tires:

- Passenger tires - \$1.50/tire
 - Light truck tires - \$2/tire
 - Heavy truck tires - \$5/tire
 - Tractor tires - \$10/tire
- Additional charge if on rims.



Electronics:

Most electronic devices contain hazardous materials. For example, monitors and TV's contain 7 lbs. of lead. The following charges offset the cost of hazardous material removal and recycling:

- Computer Monitors - \$7
- Televisions under 19"- \$8
- Televisions over 19"- \$15
- Large console televisions - \$20
- Desktop printers/fax/copiers - \$3
- Large printers/fax/copiers - \$15
